Mass on Wednesday, April 5th is planned by Grade 1. Please plan to join us in the Chapel at 9:30 am where we put first things first.

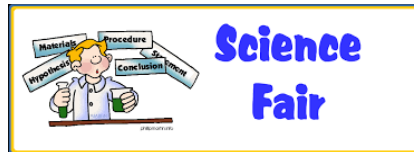
Penance Service
