



Holy Cross Catholic School Active Parent/Guardian Scholarship

Young 5's-Fifth Grade students and parents/guardians who pledge to be active partners in the Catholic education and faith development of their child(ren) will receive the Active Parent Scholarship. This is not a new scholarship. Most families have qualified for this tuition reduction in the past, without a required application. An application process for these funds was first instituted in 2019. All families are eligible to receive an Active Parent Scholarship which ranges from \$2,475 - \$5,050 . The amount awarded varies per family and is determined after all other scholarships have been applied to your tuition. **With the assistance of the Active Parent Scholarship, families typically will not pay any more than \$2,075 per student for the 2020-21 school year.**
