All nominees will be recognized for their nomination at the 2019 Excellence in Youth Leadership Reception to be held Sunday May 19th at 2:00PM at the Knights of Columbus Hall in Defiance Ohio. Nominations will be judged by an independent group of volunteer judges. One student from each grade category (K-3, 4-6, 7-9 and 10-12) will receive the 2019 Excellence in Youth Leadership Award. Winners will be announced at the reception. The winner of each category will receive a \$250 stipend to award to a Defiance County nonprofit organization of their choice. Winners will also be recognized with a plaque and will be featured in a future news article in The Crescent-News. All nominees will receive a nominee ribbon and free admission to the Youth Leadership Reception.

Reception attendees will receive an inspiring message from a special key note speaker (to be announced) that will encourage the leader in everyone! All students 12th grade and under are admitted free with an adult (even if not nominated). Adult admission is \$10 with advanced reservation or \$15 at the door. Nominations must be received by 4:00 April 1, 2019.

1. **Be Proactive** – Proactive leaders take responsibility for their actions and understand they are in charge of their success. They don't blame genetics, circumstances, conditions, or conditioning for their behavior. They understand that they choose their behavior.
2. **Begin with the End in Mind** – Begin with the End in Mind means to begin each day, task, or project with a clear vision of your desired direction and destination.
3. **Put First Things First** – Prioritizing what is important makes all the difference in experiencing success. Leaders who practice this habit work, then "play".
4. **Think Win-Win** – Leaders who focus on the goals of those they are working with can experience a "win-win". Win-win sees life as a cooperative arena, not a competitive one. Win-win is a frame of mind and heart that constantly seeks mutual benefit in all human interactions. Win-win means agreements or solutions are mutually beneficial and satisfying.
5. **Seek First to Understand, then to be Understood** – Leaders who practice this habit listen, and try to understand other perspectives without making assumptions.
6. **Synergize** – Synergize is the habit of creative cooperation. It is teamwork, open-mindedness, and the adventure of finding new solutions to old problems.
7. **Sharpen the Saw** – Sharpen the Saw means preserving and enhancing the greatest asset you have—you. It means having a balanced program for self-renewal in the four areas of your life: physical, social/emotional, mental, and spiritual.
